We accept applications through high schools and equivalents only. Supervisors are expected to fill [the form](#) (Please use MS Excel template) and to send it to koudairenkei@office.chiba-u.jp by e-mail in the period from August 21nd (Mon) to August 28th (Mon) 12:00 (sharp). The subject of the e-mail should be [Chiba-u-poster:name_of_your_school](#). Please let us remind you the deadline is sharp.

The following items should be listed in [the application form](#).

(1) Fields

Choose the field most appropriated for your poster paper from the following list and identify it by the number.

1. Physics I: General Physics
2. Physics II: Mechanical engineering, Electric engineering, civil and building engineering, robotics, aeronautics, and related engineering.
3. Chemistry I: Physical chemistry, Inorganic chemistry, Analytical

chemistry, and related chemistry

4. Chemistry II: Organic chemistry, Biochemistry, Environmental chemistry, and related chemistry
5. Biology I: Animal science, Nutrition, Pathology, Physiology, and relate sciences
6. Biology II: Botany, Horticulture, Microbiology, and related sciences.
7. Geology
8. Mathematics and Information science

(2) Title

It should be written in 10.5 point characters and shorter than 56 characters including space. The subtitle, if you have, should be written in the same cell but in the second line.

(3) Affiliation (high school), authors, kana, and the number of authors.

All the authors should be listed in the second column. The principal author (PA) should be designated by placing a circle before her/him if you have coauthors.

The third column, kana, should remain blank when the names of authors are given in alphabet.

(4) Abstract

It should be written in 10.5 point characters and should be shorter than 50 words. The column height should be adjusted accordingly.

(5) Mentor

The name of the mentor (high school teacher). Leave blank if you do not have a mentor on the research.

(6) Contact address

The contact person should be a high school teacher who has supervised the research. The e-mail address is mandatory.

(7) Emergency call

Please let us know the mobile phone of the supervisor or one of the authors so that we can contact you in case of emergency.

(8) Postal address of the high school

(Note) We assume that the poster paper is written and explained in

English if the application form is written in English. In addition, note that the title, affiliation, authors, and abstract are printed in abstract booklet and appear in Web page of Chiba University.
